FIFTY YEARS AGO IN THE SACRED HEART COURIER

The year 1962 was an exciting time in the United States. Sam Walton opened the first Wal-Mart store in Bentonville, Arkansas. Astronaut John Glenn, Jr. became the first American to orbit the earth during Friendship 7 orbit and the oral polio vaccine developed by Albert Sabin was given to millions of children to fight polio.



Popular movies included West

Side Story, Spartacus, Lawrence of Arabia and To Kill A Mockingbird. The Beatles, Bob Dylan, Neil Sadaka and of course Chubby Checkers (who can forget the "Twist") were popular singers. On TV we were watching The Monkees, Route 66, Ironside, Gilligan's Island and many other hit



shows. A Ford Galaxie 500 XL sold for \$3350 and an electric sewing machine cost \$49.95.

Meanwhile back on Canal Street in the heart of New Orleans, Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish had welcomed Father Thomas

Peyton, C.S.C. as Pastor. Senior leaders for the class of 1962 were Ingrid Hokanson, Joan Dantonio, Lynda Heider and Daryl Leslie, The Senior Valentine queen was Rose Johnson. The Mikado was the play of the year, only Sacred Heart students could bring such Japanese flair to New Orleans.

Over 300 students participated in the play under the direction of Sister Mary Dorothy, SSND. On May 4, 1962 the theme of the Junior-Senior Prom was "Gay Paree". The girls wore chiffon, silks

and beaded tops and the bouffant hair do's completed the look.

A replica of France's Eiffel Tower greeted all as they entered the gym. The Counts provided the music for the evening. The seniors then embarked on a trip to New York City



aboard the Southerner train with Father Joseph Fey along as one of the chaperones. They visited many of the most popular sites there. On May 30, 1962, the seniors of the class of 1962 proudly walked up the aisle of Sacred Heart of Jesus Church for a morning mass followed by a lovely brunch in the cafeteria. Later that evening they received their long awaited diplomas. This class has left an indelible mark in the history book of Sacred Heart High School. Enjoy your 50th reunion celebration!


