FIFTY YEARS AGO - 1963

The year 1963 was filled with many historic and interesting events. President John F. Kennedy was assassinated on November 22 in Dallas, Texas. Vice-President Lyndon Baines Johnson was sworn in as President on Air Force One just two hours after the assassination. Martin Luther King



delivered his "I have a Dream" speech in Washington, DC. Pope John XXIII died in Rome and Pope Paul VI was chosen to succeed him. In the United States AT&T introduced the touch tone phone and zip codes were used for the first time by the post office. The Studebaker car went out of production and the Sabin Polio vaccine was given nationwide. Popular movies included Cleopatra, Lawrence of Arabia, Mutiny on the Bounty and To Kill



a Mockingbird. TV shows like the Flintstones, The Andy Griffith Show, Mister Ed and the Dick Van Dyke Show aired in our homes. The Beatles released "I Want to Hold Your Hand" with "I Saw Her Standing There" on the reverse side of the record in 1963. Charles de Gaulle was President of France and Nikita Khrushchev ruled

Russia. Underwood manual typewriters sold for \$119.99 and a Plymouth Sport Fury car sold for \$285.00 new. A pound of bacon cost 29 cents, gas was 29 cents a gallon and a loaf of bread sold for 22 cents. Meanwhile back at 3222 Canal Street in New Orleans, Sacred Heart High

School also had an interesting and exciting year. Sister Mary Naoma, SSND, served as Principal and Father Thomas Peyton, CSC, was Pastor of our



church. Pat Tessitore was Class President, Karolyn Champon was Vice-President, Marie St. Romain was Secretary and Judy Cricchio served as Treasurer. The Dramarians presented two plays: "Western Melodrama" and "Summons of Sariel." Sister Raymunda was head librarian, and the Choral Club, under the direction of Sister Madeleva, sang Christmas carols on WYES TV on Christmas night. "Gay Paree" was the theme of the Junior-Senior Prom where everybody "twisted" the night away. The talent show theme was "Under the Big Top"

and was directed by Sister Mary Dorothy. Sister Rose Ann was moderator of the year book and many hearts worked together to compile the "Heart" yearbook. Sports played a big part in the lives of many Sacred Heart girls. The CSMC and Sodality were also popular. As one student put it, "Our Fondest Memory is Sacred Heart Itself." Enjoy your 50th anniversary everybody!


