The Archdiocese of New Orleans has purchased property related to Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish but it is not clear exactly what property was sold. The

Church and rectory are shuttered. The gym and two lots are for sale as reported in the New Orleans Times Picayune newspaper on August 19, 2012. The Gulf Coast Housing Partnership, along with Unity of Greater New Orleans and the Common Ground Institute, have acquired the Malta Square building on Canal Street. The mixed-income project will use half of the units for low-income people with disabilities and the remaining units for low-income workers.
